

Privacy Notice- A565 Junction Improvements Phase 1 (July 2026)

Sefton Council would like to tell you about our Privacy Notice for the consultation on the A565 Formby Bypass Junction Improvements. This privacy notice will explain what we do with the information we collect.

In this form we will collect information about:

- IP addresses (this is a computer code to show what computer the information comes from).
- Information about your connection to the area (for example, whether you live, work, own land, or regularly travel through the area).
- Your views and comments on the proposed junction improvements.
- Equalities monitoring information.

Why we collect and use this information.

Sefton Council is seeking feedback on proposed improvements at junctions along the A565 Formby Bypass. The information collected will help us understand local views on the proposals and how the improvements may affect people who live, work, travel through, or have an interest in the area.

IP addresses that identify computers.

- The IP addresses are collected to make sure there are not lots of responses from one address.
- Once this is checked the IP address information is deleted.

Equalities Monitoring.

- This information is collected so we can identify any comments from protected characteristics.

How long we keep your information.

The IP address will be deleted immediately after the checks are done. All other information will be kept until the project is finished.

How we use the information and who we share the information with.

The information collected in this questionnaire will be used to understand how our proposals may impact you and your interests.

Storing the information.

All information is kept safe. Sefton Council follows the laws around data protection.

The laws.

We need to make sure we

- Only ask the questions we need to in the questionnaire.

The law says we must ask and act on this information.

Confidential

The data we collect will be shared within the Council and with partner organisations in order to identify any key design concerns and initiate further discussions about the proposals. The answers will be collected to help us know what people think.

Who will we share this information with?

The information in this survey will only be shared within the Council and partner organisations.
