





It said the Green car park would be a good site to develop.





We want to improve the public spaces around Crosby Town Centre. This will encourage people to travel in different ways. This could such as walking, cycling and using the buses.




Our plans also include putting spaces for electric charging of vehicles in the car parks.


Our vision for Crosby is that it is accessible for everyone and a Connected Crosby.
