Two Proposed New Routes in Southport


Route 1 - Hesketh Park to the Plough Roundabout





Birkdale to Hillside Shops via Alma Road and Dover Road

 Aughton Road (From York Road), Upper Aughton Road, Alma Road, Birkdale Village (Liverpool Road), Welbeck Road, Walmer Road, Crosby Road, Dover Road and Hillside Road.


































# Birkdale to Hillside Shops via Alma Road and Dover Road

Upper Aughton Road (between York Road and Alma Road) -Walking and Cycling Friendly Street

- Making the side roads easier to cross for people walking by widening the footway
- Reducing the width of the road
- Making parking bays

#### Alma Road – Quiet Street

 Filter at Alma Road /Liverpool Road.

Birkdale Village (Liverpool Road)

- More cycle parking
- Improved crossings for people walking
